- Provided with roughage or grazing.

AANWYSINGS:

Voorgestelde daaglikse inname:

Voer tussen 500 - 700 g per 100 kg liggaamsmassa afhangende van kondisie verlang;

- Goeie gehalte ruvoer of weiding moet vrylik beskikbaar wees.
- NPN Vry.

Wenke:

- Maak seker dat jou perd altyd skoon, koel en vars drinkwater het;
- Maak seker dat jou perd hoë kwaliteit ruvoer en weiding kry;
- Voer daaglik jou perd op dieselfde tyd;
- Moenie radikale veranderinge aan jou perd se dieët maak nie, doen dit geleidelik as dit moet;
- Moet nooit 'n perd in 'n stal of toe area sit terwyl hulle nog sweetrig is en swaar asemhaal nie;
- Moet nooit koue water op 'n warm perd gooi nadat daar gery is nie;
- Ondersoek jou perd na elke sessie wat jy gery het.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Recommended daily intake:

Feed between 500 - 700 g per 100 kg body weight depending on condition desired;

- Good quality roughage or grazing must be freely available.
- NPN Free.

Tips:

- Make sure your horse is always clean, cool and has fresh drinking water;
- Make sure your horse has high quality roughage and grazing;
- Feed your horse at the same time every day;
- Do not make radical changes to your horse's diet, do it gradually if need be;
- Never put a horse in a stable or enclosed area while still sweaty and breathing heavily;
- Never pour cold water on a hot horse after it was ridden;
- Examine your horse after each ride.
